

1100 Litre Giant Home Wheelie Bin Service – Short Term Hire (STH)

Thank you for choosing the Giant wheelie bin service from Grist Environmental and please take note of the following information:

Please do:

- Locate the wheelie bin on your private property, not on a pavement or highway, and on flat level hardstand, not grass.
- Wear gloves and thoroughly wash your hands with soap and water, as per Government advice, before and after using the wheelie bin.
- Lock the wheels at all times.

Please don't:

- Attempt to move the wheelie bin or release the brake
- Overfill the bin The lid must close
- Fill it with very heavy material. When we collect the bin, we need to move it safely.

Food & Drink Cartons (including Tetrapaks)	Fluorescent Light Tubes
Clothes, Textiles and Shoes	Printer Cartridges
Small Items of Furniture	Large Items of Furniture/Mattresses
Garden Waste	Tyres
Small Gas Bottles	Large Gas Bottles
Glasses (spectacles)	Low Energy Light Bulbs
Household Black Bag Waste (excess)	Paint - oil based
Mobile Phones	Paint - water based
Plastics (Bottles/ packaging & rigid plastics)	Chemicals
Small items of Scrap Metal	Large items of Scrap Metal
Sheet Glass & Bottle Glass (clear/coloured)	Asbestos
Small items of Wood and Timber	Large items of Wood and Timber
50 kg of Soil or Rubble	More than 50kg of Soil or Rubble

Car batteries: May be placed by the side of the bin for collection at the same time as the bin but for safe transportation and recycling reasons should not go inside the bin.
