- 1. Appointment of Chairman
  - PA is re-elected for 2023/24, proposed by SW and seconded by GZ
- 2. Apologies for absence
  - Apologies received from Paul Oatway, Mark Loveday
- 3. Minutes of Meeting held on 16 March 2023 and Matters Arising
  - The minutes of the meeting were approved
  - SW will obtain a quote for an additional "Unsuitable for HGV" sign for Manor Farm Lane
- 4. Finance Report, Statement of Accounts 2022/23 and AGAR review
  - Movements since the meeting on 16 March 2023 are instant access interest of £9.04; income received £1,699.90 (Precept £1500, VAT refund £199.90); payments made £143.86 (Heart Internet website hosting). Bank balance of £9813.26 on 23 May 2023, consisting of £2,280.80 on current account and £7,532.46 on instant access account

    - Income £1,900.48, expenditure £2,343.87, balance -£443.39 (cf. approved budget income £1,669.50, expenditure £4,473.96 (reduced spend on defibrillator hire, now paid annually, and platinum jubilee event))

  - Training is scheduled for 3pm on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> June, at Woodside Manor Farm; please gather at the farm entrance at 2:45pm if you are planning to attend, and bring a chair if you wish
- 8. Highways & Rights of Way
  - Woodland Road sign has been moved to Patney village sign at the river bridge
  - Following the issue raised in the previous Council Meeting, a meeting with the WC Senior Traffic Engineer is arranged for 23<sup>rd</sup> June to review the on-road parking in the vicinity of 6-16 Woodland Road
