- 1. Apologies for absence
 - Apologies received from Paul Oatway, Nigel Thursby
- 2. Minutes of Meeting held on 04 October 2023 and Matters Arising
 - The minutes of the meeting were approved
- 3. Parish Councillor vacancy
 - A vacancy exists for a Parish Councillor; if you would like to join the Parish Council please let SW know (<u>patneyparishclerk@outlook.com</u>). This is an important role, and helps ensure the interests and concerns of Patney residents are represented
- 4. Finance Report
 - Movements since the meeting on 04 October 2023 are instant access interest of £15.30; income received - £0; payments made - £46.80 (idVerde waste bin). Bank balance of £8,164.89 on 05 December 2023, consisting of £594.58 on current account and £7,570.31 on instant access account
 - Budget 2024/25: no major expenditure is anticipated during the next financial year; the proposed budget was approved, including a parish precept of £1500
 - Investing £5,000 into a higher-interest savings account was approved; SW will apply for a 'Council Savings' account with Cambridge Building Society
- 5. Annual Review of Parish Council policies and procedures
 - No changes are recommended for the existing set of documents, other than for SW to update the review date on each document
- 6. Planning Applications
 - PL/2023/08215 50 Woodland Road has been approved
 - PL/2023/10022- 4 Pucklands. The consultation deadline 25/12/2023

- 7. Parish Steward
 - 2024 schedule has not yet been published; next visit expected in early January
- 8. Defibrillator
 - This is now registered on 'The Circuit', the national defibrillator network, so we're now able to submit reports online rather than by email
- 9. Highways & Rights of Way
 - Regarding traffic speeds through the village the Parish Council will proceed with applying to WC to conduct a traffic survey, after which any further action can be considered
 - The obstruction across Hail Bridge has been reported on the MyWilts app
- 10. Matters from the public
 - The recent flooding at the north end of Woodland Road has been reported on the MyWilts app; in addition, the Parish Council will determine the cost of having the road sweeper come in order to clear the road of autumn leaf fall
 - Refurbishment of the phone box was discussed, including research done earlier in the year on costings and how other parishes have approached this; it was generally agreed that since the phone box is a village asset serving as a book exchange and newspaper drop, it should be maintained and not left to deteriorate; it was also felt that refurbishment is an appropriate way to commemorate the King's Coronation; SW will continue to gather costings, for review in 2024
- 11. Dates of future meetings
 - The next PPC meeting is scheduled for 21 March 2024
